Code Signed For Fair Competition In Grain Markets

WASHINGTON, March 20 (AP)—Secretary Wallace today signed the code of fair competition for the grain exchanges.

It provides a code authority of seven members for enforcement duties, establishes a uniform trade practice which include wage minimum margin requirements, fixes the fluctuation range per bushel in grain prices and provides for establishment of a business conduct committee for each exchange.

The code also provides that reports, regulations, and rules provided by the grain futures act shall not be dispensed with.

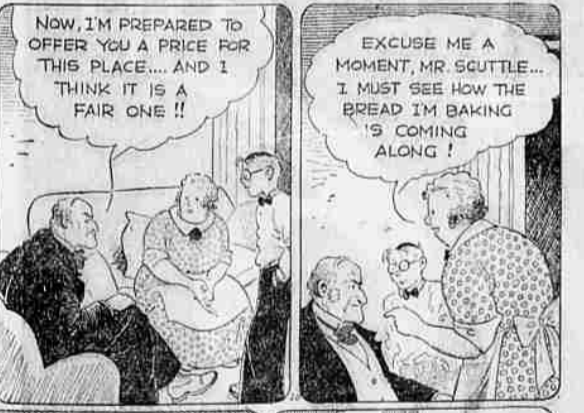

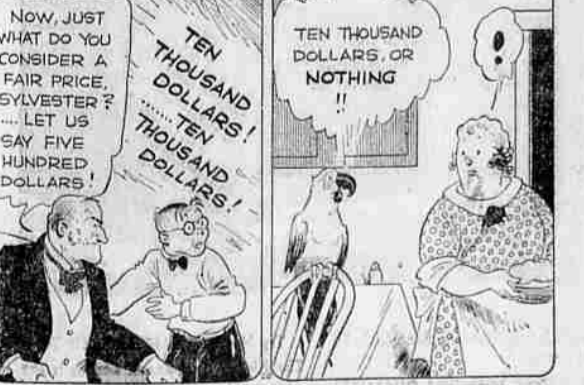
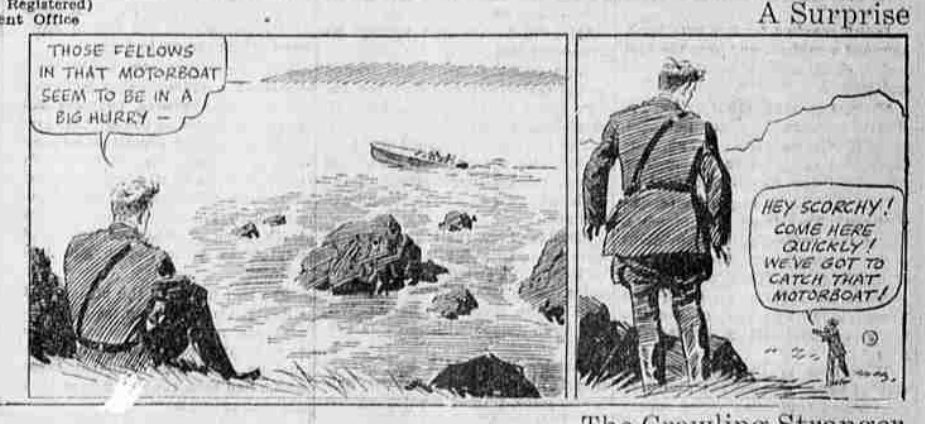
