

### RAY GILL RAPS TAX PROPONENTS

PORTLAND, Mar. 28 (AP) — In answer to charges made by the "School Relief and Property Tax Reduction League of Oregon," that communistic influences of Oregon are attacking President Roosevelt's measures for farm and unemployment relief, and that men "long identified with communistic activities" are executive committee members of the anti-sales tax federation, Ray W. Gill late Tuesday declared the accusations were "the most contemptible propaganda yet put out by the sales tax proponents."

Gill is master of the state grange and head of the anti-sales tax federation.

"This statement made by the sales tax proponents shows how desperate they are," Gill declared, "and to what lengths they will go. I openly challenge this attempt to drag a 'red herring' into the sales tax fight."

"It is an attempt to brand the anti-sales tax federation with the brush of communism."
