## U. P. DERAILMENT SUSPECT JAILED

RAWLINS, Wyo., Mar. 29 (AP) — Derailment of the Union Pacific railroad's fast Portland Rose passenger train near here Friday night was the work of an ex-convict who fled without a penny in loot, officers disclosed here.

Scores of passengers narrowly escaped death or serious injury as six coaches and the locomotive, of the transcontinental train piled up in a ditch.

Horace G. Lovett, said by Sheriff John McPherson to be a former convict at Colorado and Missouri prisons, is held in jail here. McPherson said he confessed.

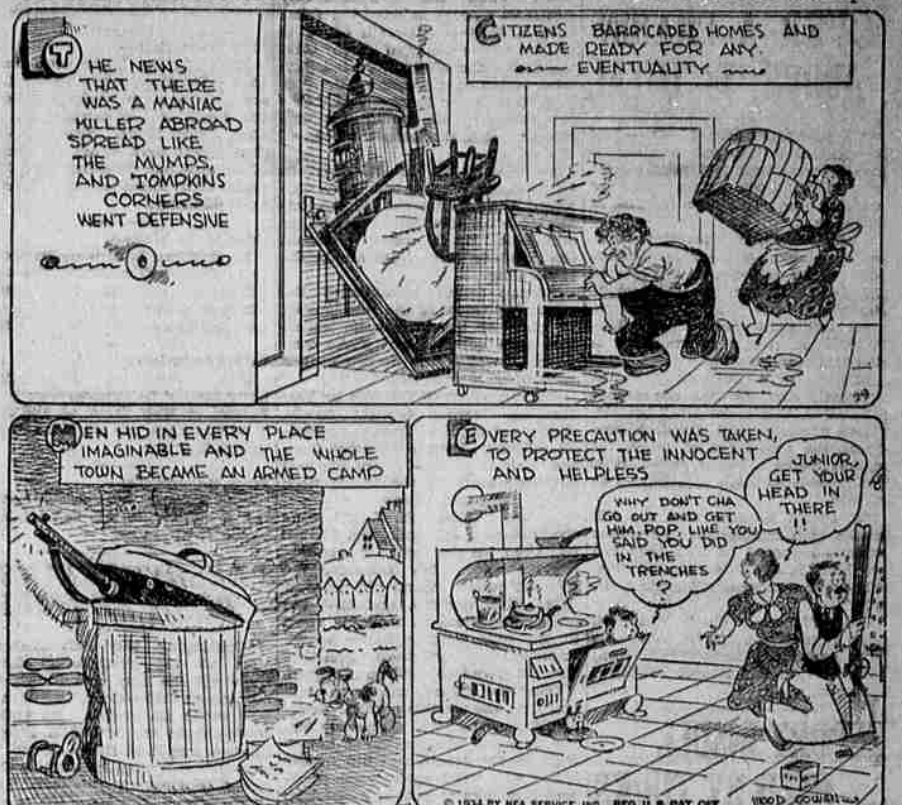

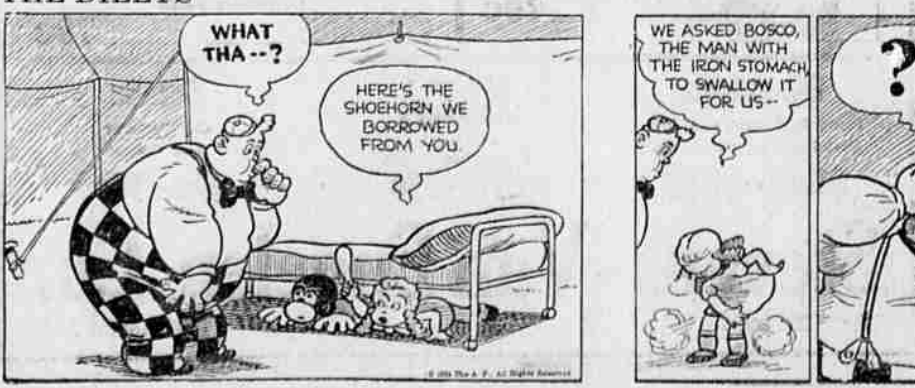
