

### Charge Against HOLC Will Be Investigated

PORTLAND, Ore. (AP) — Charges of irregularity in the handling of loan applications by the Oregon branch of the home owners' loan corporation will be investigated by the federal home loan bank board in Washington, D. C., according to information received here by Fred W. German who

presented the complaints. German has charged that in some instances worthy applicants were being denied aid, that some applications received no attention, that some applications have been approved and then, without explanation, have been cancelled, and that heavy mortgages were first and second mortgages. German, former county commissioner, previously complained to the HOLC board at Washington, but his communication was referred back to J. P. Lipscomb.

### Idaho Governor Wants No "Dole" For Gem Staters

BOISE, Idaho, Apr. 12 (AP) — Denouncing plans of the relief administration to extend direct relief instead of work relief to rural communities, Governor C. Ben Ross declared Wednesday "we don't want the dole in Idaho, and we won't have it." Advised that the relief administration program was to set up work projects only in the larger communities and industrial centers without providing work for rural areas, the governor said "such a program will not continue long in Idaho." "If necessary I will go to Washington and protest to congress about it," the governor declared. "Work

should be provided in stranded rural communities as well as in other places. "It doesn't cost the government any more to let a man work for what he gets than it does to give it to him without work."
