"SEE OREGON FIRST" PLEA OF STEVENSON

"See Oregon first" should be the motto of every Oregonian," stated Elmo Stevenson, instructor in biology at the Eastern Oregon Normal school when speaking on "Geology of Eastern Oregon" at an assembly Tuesday. "We Oregonians should be very proud of our state with its unusually interesting geologic formations, its beautiful scenery, its varieties of animal life and its natural resources. Nowhere in the world could you rival such variety of scenery within so small a compass."

In the course of his talk, Mr. Stevenson sketched the geologic history and development of Eastern Oregon. He told how the Grande Ronde valley was at one time a large lake and traced in an interesting manner the formation of Mt. Emily, Mt. Pantry, the Grande Ronde valley, the changing of the course of Catherine creek, the Hot Lake-Telocast fault, etc. He illustrated his talk with several charts which showed the different phases of development.
