"Until May 20, when the weather broke, California faced one of the worst fire seasons in its history. A few more days of this kind of weather and the situation will return to normal."

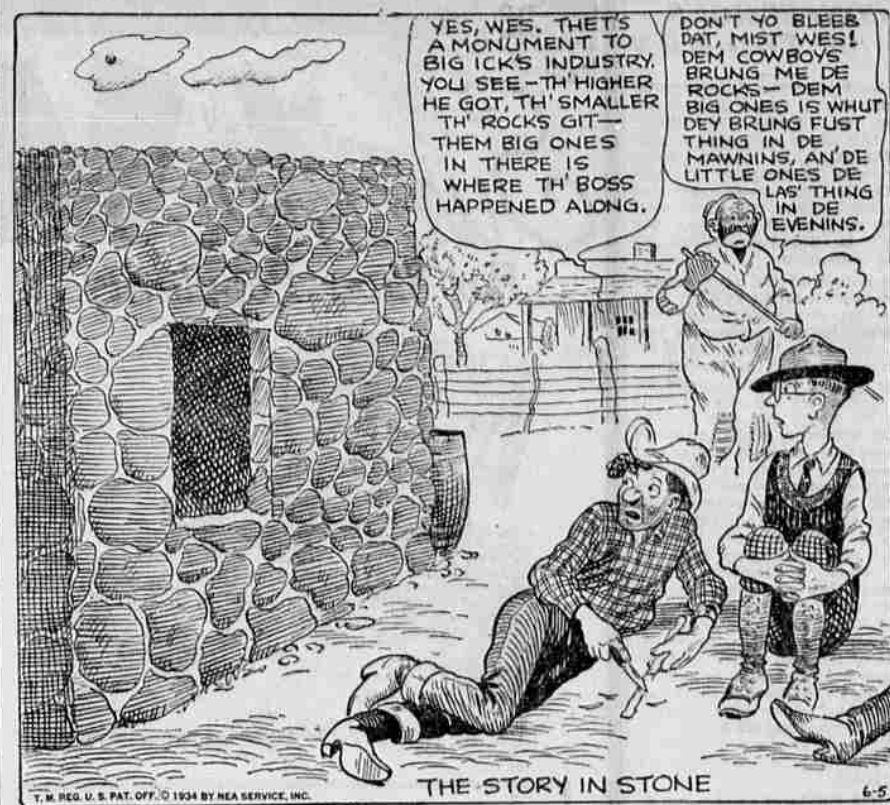

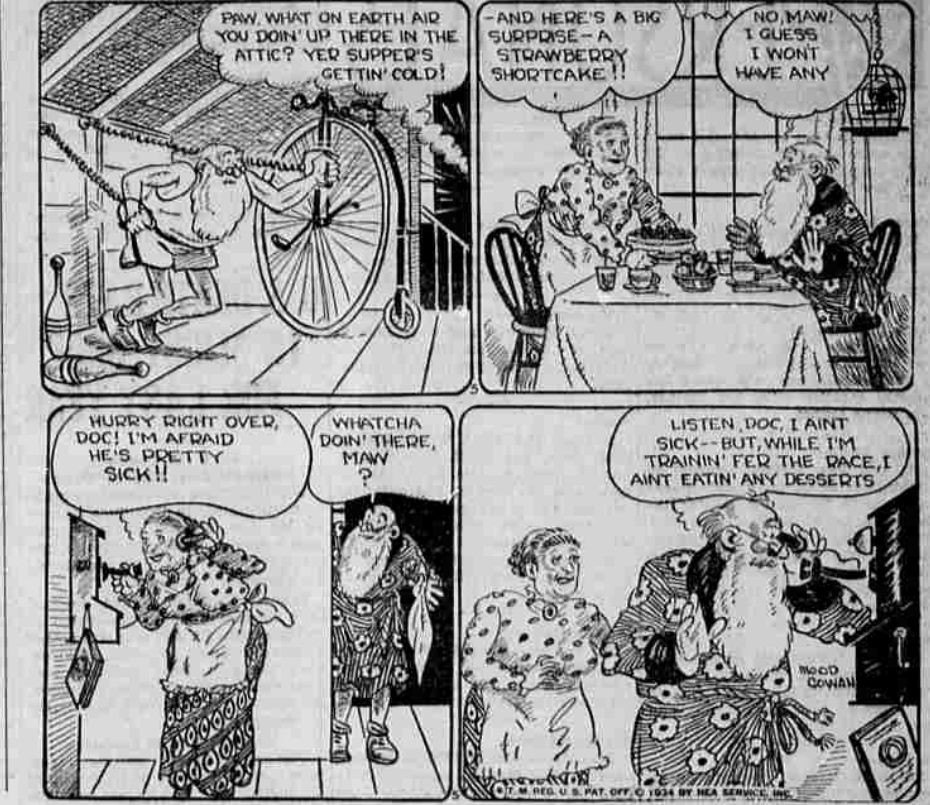
