SAD SAM GIBSON WINS 18-INNING PITCHING BATTLE

Sad Sam Gibson may be excused for smiling a bit today.

San Francisco's doleful twirler came out on top last night in the Coast League's greatest 1934 pitching duel, beating Dutch Lieber of the Missions in 18 grueling innings, 5-1.

The Stars banged three Angel hurriers for 17 hits to win the opener 12-7, despite four baggers by Smead Jolley and Vinet Di Maggio, Hollywood outfielders, the Angels took the short second game, 7-4.

Four baggers by Tobin, Berger and Ellsworth and a triple by Berger powered Seattle to a 9-1 win over Portland to even the series 1-1. Howard Craighead was hit freely by the Beavers but went the route.

Tallying seven runs in the first three innings and another in the fifth, Sacramento romped through to an 8-1 triumph over Oakland. Manuel Salvo limited the Oaks to seven hits.

City Maintains Its Position on Retailing

that she was quitting her beer business to give Gardiner an opportunity to open an establishment here.

The commissioners also acted on a request from the SEPA asking if additional contributions toward office rental could be expected from the city, which at present is paying \$10 per month toward rental of the rooms in the Sacajawea Annex. The commission turned the matter over to the manager with power to act, and the understanding the SEPA would be notified that La Grande would be unable to furnish any additional funds for rental payments.

Bills for the month of June were ordered paid in the amount of \$2,022.95. The manager's report showed \$2009.36 in general warrants retired, and a \$1,000 water bond paid during the last fortnight. Cash on hand totaled \$4,189.53, divided as follows: La Grande bank \$1,876.93, Portland bank \$238.08, cash \$1,115.78 and the remainder in warrants.
