Brady, a life-long friend and admirer of the deceased, assisted by several priests of the diocese of Baker, Ore. This memorial service will take place at 9 o'clock sharp, and all friends, acquaintances, and admirers of the departed priest are cordially invited to attend the service in the Church of Our Lady of the Valley. It was the present pastor of the local church who pronounced the panegyric of the departed priest at his solemn obsequies, traveling over 600 miles to witness the last rites for a high type of citizen, a lover of young folks, a stalwart and uncompromising American citizen, a priest of unselfish spirit and soul, whose ideal as such was the welfare of fellowmen. Father Driscoll was an ardent patriot during the war, and he frequently invited the present pastor of the church to come to La Grande and espouse the various appeals authorized by the United States government. Father Driscoll left the impress of his personality upon the citizens of La Grande regardless of creed or nationality; the city of La Grande went on record the day of his funeral to commend his Americanism and public
