PORTLAND WINS AGAIN; SEATTLE CLINCHES SERIES

Even the over-whipped Portland Beavers have caught some of the winning fever Seattle's Indians brought to California on their current Coast league invasion. The Portlanders, now functioning under the acting management of George Burns, former Seattle and Missions pilot, nosed out Oakland 4-3 last night to take a 3-1 lead in the series. Sloppy fielding spoiled what otherwise would have been a neat pitching duel between George Caster of Portland and Hal Heid of Oakland. Four Acord errors let in three of the Beaver runs, while two Oakland tallies were the result of three Portland bores. Claybaugh's triple drove in the only earned Beaver run in the eighth.

Seattle continued its upward climb by making it four straight at Sacramento, 6-3, and clinching the series.

CALIFORNIANS 'DROPPING' LAWN FOR ROCK

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) - If the rock garden craze continues to grow, lawns may become a rarity.

Plant quarantine stations on California borders report that Californians in increasing numbers are bringing home colored rocks and stones with unusual markings from Nevada, Oregon and other states, to be used in building rock gardens.

Lawns in many of the state's cities have been dug up to make room for the bright hued stones, among which in many instances bright colored wild flowers are planted. Many rock garden enthusiasts also plant cactus.

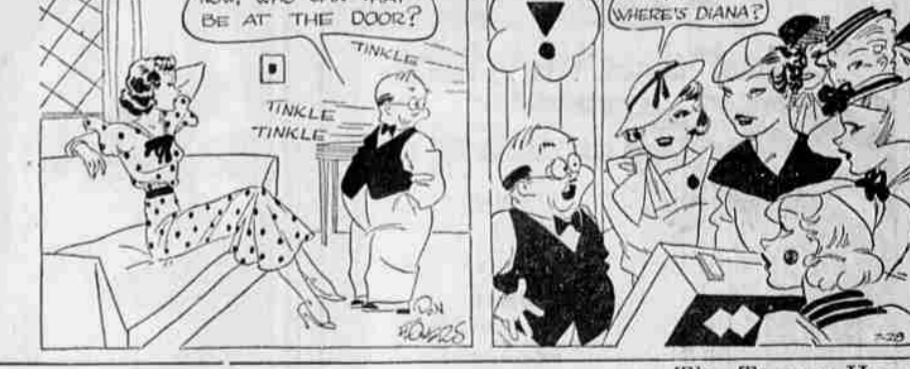
