tions with the reich. Britain is anxious. So, too, are lesser nations.

The general impression is that the coming winter will bring the supreme test for Hitler. The economic difficulties ahead may make or break him, many believe. If he can surmount the host of domestic troubles during the next eight or nine months, he probably will be sure of an indefinite reign, it is felt in most capitals. What he will do for international peace worries nations more than Germany's internal situation.
