assurance by the federal housing administration sets forth that "notes may be signed by lessees, other than those which may be classed as owners, provided that the lease requires the lessee to make alterations, repairs and improvements. And provided, further, that the final termination date of the lease is at least six months beyond the final maturity of the note." In such cases, a certified copy of the lease must be furnished to the financial institution at the time the note is purchased.
