were described as holding the opinion that slight improvement has occurred in the drought area in the last three days.

The president authorized Williams to dismiss immediately any federal relief worker who is a candidate for office this year or who prefers to participate actively in the political campaign. Williams reported a "general difficulty" along this line in many states. Williams said he thought the \$525,000,000 for drought relief probably would be sufficient for relief needs alone. He and Secretary Wallace arranged a conference for late today to draft the food purchase program.

The government also is about to start a huge land-buying program so industrial workers can have better and cheaper vacations. The National Park service said today it is an important phase of the plan to retire poor land from agriculture. It calls for large recreational spots within easy reach of most of the major manufacturing cities.

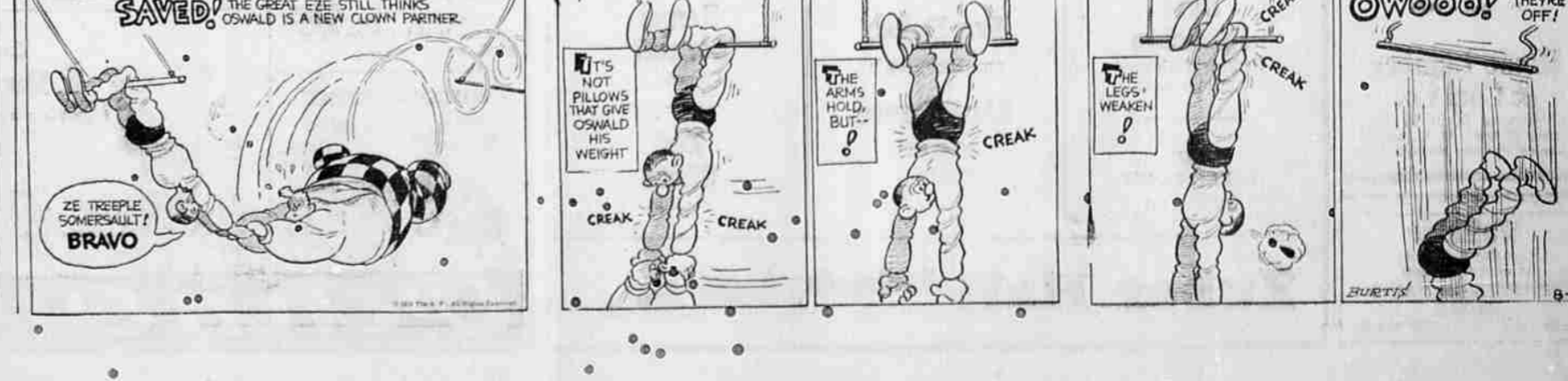
