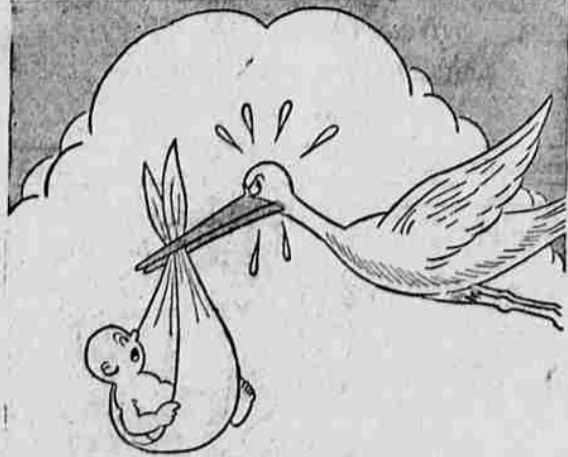

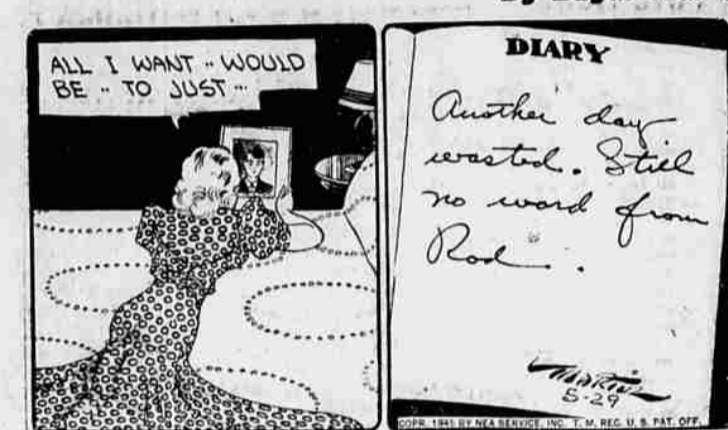

Huge Refinery Idle In Wildcat Strike

PORT ARTHUR, Tex., May 25 (UP)—Gulf Oil's mammoth Port Arthur refinery, one of the world's largest producers of high-octane gasoline, stood idle today as 3,500 CIO workmen carried their wildcat strike into its third day.

The shutdown threw 5,000 employees into idleness. Some 1,500 AFL workers were forced to stop work as the result of the walkout Saturday of the 3,500 CIO men.
