SALEM (UPI) — Senate bill 503 which increases salaries of Oregon legislators from \$600 a year to \$175 a month was passed by the Senate and sent to the House. If passed and signed by the governor the salary increase will be used as a test case before the Oregon Supreme Court on the question of the right of legislators to increase their own salaries.
