N. Y. STOCKS

NEW YORK (UPI)—Stocks rallied irregularly today.
Tuesday's decline attracted buyers early in the session when the electronics registered wide gains and many special issues moved ahead. Enough of the leaders rose to help restore some of the industrial group's loss. Rails dipped most of the day but many were firmer as the close neared.
Utilities registered their 12th decline in 13 sessions. Aluminum issues ruled strong with gains ranging to more than 2 points in Alcoa which has just been included in the group used to calculate the industrial average. Kennecott led the coppers higher.
Automobile issues were firmer. J.I. Case rose a point. Textron was bid up on an increase in its dividend. Litton Industries spurred when the company was named to develop a guidance system for the Eagle missile.
White Motors set a new high on a rise of more than 3 points in the truck section. Goodyear rose more than 2 in the tires. American Tobacco, Liggett & Myers and Lorillard were strong spots in the tobacco. U.S. Gypsum rose 2 1/2 in the building group and LOB Glass also was up better than 2.
Zenith rose more than 4. Texas Instruments more than 3. and Motorola nearly 3 in the electronics.
