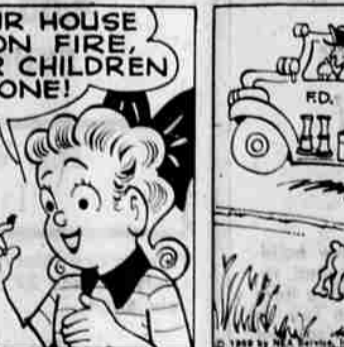

U.S. Political Theorists Want Better Cooperation

But, a means of obtaining a better coordination between the executive and legislative branches and of exerting greater pressure for agreement on overall policy has been suggested from time to time. It would require amendment of the Constitution, but it probably would be worth it. It would give cabinet members seats and speaking rights in Congress.

Proposed By Wilson

The idea is not new. Woodrow Wilson suggested it many years ago. "What is the change proposed?" he wrote. "Simply to give to the heads of the executive departments seats in Congress, with the privilege of initiative in legislation and some part of the unbounded privileges now commanded by the Standing Committees. It almost surely would lead to a smoother functioning of government."

Newton D. Baker had the same idea. He wrote:

"It is far more loyal to the memory of the founders of our government to try to be as wise in our day as they were wise in theirs than it is blindly to try to perpetuate the mere machinery they found adequate for their needs into a time when that machinery is plainly inadequate."

Wilson and Baker possessed two of the great modern political minds. Dulles was in their league as a student of government. The President would have been in good company if he just had stayed put in his news conference.
