BureauOf Standards Lists Rules To Escape Lightning

Standards hopes you know the rules for not getting hit.

As prepared by the bureau's codes and safety standards section, here they are:

A. Do not go out or stay out during thunderstorms if you don't have to. Stay inside "where it is among other things that: dry, preferably away from firedry, preferably away from fire-places, stoves, and other* metal objects."

B. If you have a choice of shel-ter, choose (in the following orin an open space.

—Lightning rods are fine if they der) large metal or metal-frame buildings, buildings protected against lightning, and, in the case of unprotected buildings, large without passing through non-conducting parts of the buse such ones rather than small.

C. If you can't avoid being out of doors, keep away from small sheds or buildings in an exposed location, and from isolated trees, wire fences, hilltops, and wide

open spaces.

D. Seek shelter in a cave, a depression in the ground, a deep valley or canyon, the foot of a steep or overhanging cliff, dense woods, or a grove of trees. "What should golfers and other

people do in thunderstorms? Get indoors if you can. Automobiles, if metal topped, are generally safe. Boats, especially sailboats, are not, unless adequate grounding is provided for masts and stays by conductors with underwater term


