



Labor Dispute Is Spreading

SALEM (UPI)—The month-long labor dispute between Willamette valley sand and gravel operators and Teamsters local 324 has spread to other crafts. Carpenters, electricians, plumbers and other craft workers walked off three construction jobs here in a "sympathy" move. Pat Blair, who represents cement contractors said "it is now apparent that this will have to be settled in the federal courts." He said an injunction would be sought to prevent picketing of jobs involving cement. Salem Building Trades Council Representative Charles Westergard said his craft employees "won't work on jobs where 'rat' cement is used." Employers Wednesday sent an ultimatum to the Teamsters telling them to return to work or risk losing their jobs.

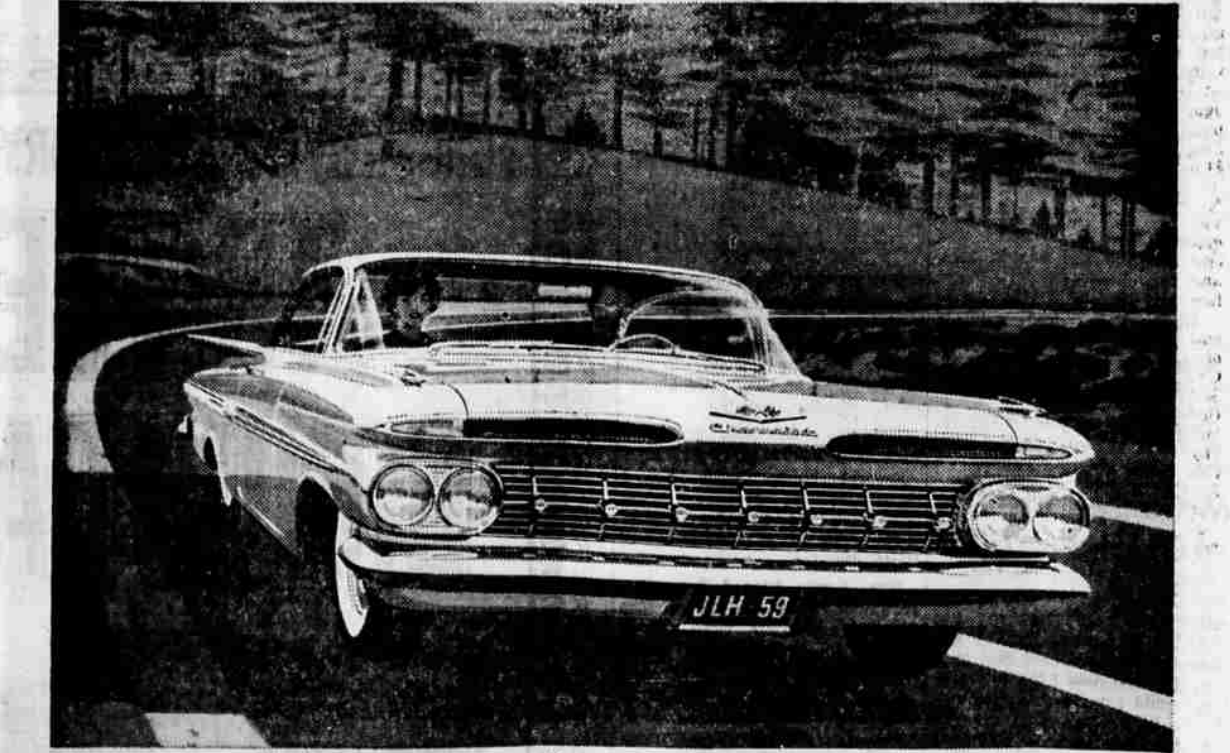
