Sleepwalker Examined Before Charges Filed

TAMPA, Fla. (UPI) — Mrs. Lucille Barnett, who said she shot her husband to death while she was sleepwalking, will be examined by psychiatrists today prior to filing of charges against her. Mrs. Barnett, 32-year-old mother of a 4-year-old daughter, told police she was awakened early Thursday by the blast of a shotgun. She said she opened her eyes to see a smoking gun in her hands and her husband lying mortally wounded on their bed. William Barnett, 29, hit in the chest with a blast from a .410 bore shotgun, died on the way to the hospital.

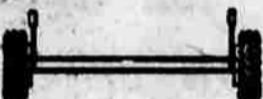
