# Not His Last Meal After All

OSSINING, N.Y. (UPI) — Con-

demned slayer Leroy Keith sat down to his specially ordered chicken dinner Wednesday night with special pleasure — he had just been informed it would not be his last meal, after all. Keith, scheduled to die in the Sing Sing Prison electric chair Wednesday night, was given an eight-day stay of execution by Gov. Nelson A. Rockefeller to avert possible public misunderstanding about his execution date. Rockefeller said it had been reported erroneously that the executions of Keith and two other men had been set ahead one day to permit official witnesses to enjoy a long Fourth of July week end. The two other men had received earlier stays of execution to permit an appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court.

# Hoffa Says His Union Giving Aid

PORTLAND (UPI) — Teamster

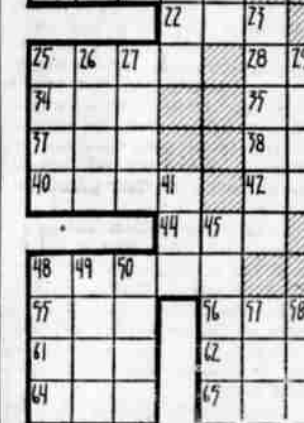
President James R. Hoffa has announced his union is giving financial support to Oregon teamsters in their strike against the Tillamook County Creamery Association. Hoffa said the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen and Helpers of America had authorized the strike and "was financially supporting it." He added the Union's action was "according to our constitution." The 62-day-old strike has resulted in a loss of nearly \$100,000 in gross sales of cheese each month, association officials have announced.

A consumer boycott conducted by the teamsters has spread throughout the 11 western states. H. S. (Beale) Dixon, general manager of the association, said cheese sales were off about 20 per cent from June of last year and estimated the gross loss at \$100,000 a month. About 160 men have been idled by the walkout.
