N. Y. STOCKS

NEW YORK (UPI)—Strength in oils helped carry the stock market into new high territory today.

In the rails, Atlantic Coast Line rose 2 points and Northern Pacific and Southern Pacific nearly 2. Kansas City Southern, an exception, lost 2 points.

Steel shares ruled strong following U.S. Steel's record first half report.

Amerasia led the oils with a gain of more than 4 points. Gains of 3 or more came into Shell, Gulf, and Richfield.

DuPont gained nearly 5 points to lift the industrial average. It sold at a new high in a strong chemical group. Aluminum issues were soft with losses ranging to more than 2 points. Motors sagged. Corning Glass was up nearly 3. Drugs produced several strong spots and one weak one—Merck which lost more than 4 points. Electronics issues met support after a dip.

until there were free elections in every country.

Eisenhower has privately expressed astonishment over the reaction of the Soviet leaders and press to the captive nations resolution. He has told visitors that he personally believes it was wholly warranted.

In his opinion, it was warranted because whenever the U.S. makes any friendly gesture towards the Soviet Union, the effect of that gesture on the peoples of the satellite nations must also be considered.

Necessity For Courtesy
In addition, the President believes that the Soviet Union has to be constantly reminded of the state of mind of the captive nations.

In all, the President's attitude to the resolution so hotly denounced by the Kremlin is that he is happy it was adopted and he was enthusiastic about it.

As for the possibilities of a Khrushchev visit, the President is known to feel that in any event any American public opinion would have to be prepared carefully ahead of time to avoid any demonstrations or rude incidents. He is mindful of the recent refusal of the mayor of Detroit to receive Soviet Deputy Premier Erol Kozlov on the latter's visit here.
