New York Stocks

NEW YORK (UPI) — Industrial shares rose again today with their average in new record high ground for the sixth session in a row.

Today's late feature in the industrial section—General Foods—ran up more than 4 points to a new high. Earlier DuPont had set a new high at 27 3/4, up 4 points and later slipped back on realizing.

A long list of other industrials moved higher. Steels, oils and motors recorded gains. Tires were strong. Aluminums recovered part of last week's late decline. International Nickel jumped more than 2 in its section. Texaco made a new high in the petroleum group.

Profit taking reduced many of the earlier gains but on the whole the market appeared higher. Railroad issues ruled firm for a time but their performance was a poor one compared with industrials.

Several specials moved up. Carter Products made a new high after Standard & Poor's selected as a stock for action. Commercial Credit ran up more than 2 when that service selected it as a stock of the month.

General, up nearly 2 points, led its section. U.S. Steel rose more than a point. Reynolds Metals gained 3 points. Crane was up nearly 2 in the building section.
