ragged youth shackled to the wall of the small Martinez home Saturday. A six-foot chain was clamped around Igoacio's left and hammered into wall with nails,

He had been chained for about six hours when deputies arrived Deputies said the youth com-plained that in addition to being chained his father also beat him with the flat side of a machete.
