A fire which threatened the town of Beatty northwest of Klamath Falls Saturday was confined to about 20 acres. It burned an old schoolhouse gym.

The State Forestry Department announced new closure restrictions for power-driven machinery and equipment within one-eighth mile of forest lands in zones 10, 11, 13, 15 and 18 in southwestern Oregon.
