NOTICE is hereby given that the survey, plan and report prepared by the City Engineer of the City of La Grande, in accordance with Ordinance Number 1558, Series 1947, Section 1, pursuant to Resolution Number 1704, Series 1959, is on file in the office of the Recorder-Treasurer of the City of La Grande at the City Building in said City, having been filed with said Recorder-Treasurer on the 29th day of May, 1959.

The probable cost of the proposed improvement is \$4,590.30. A brief statement of the area proposed to be assessed therefor is as follows:
