**NEW YORK STOCKS**  
NEW YORK (UPI) — Stocks declined again today with the industrial average touching a new low since June 23.

Losses ranged from more than \$1 a share in the main list.  
At the lows the wider losses centered on such issues as Motorola, Abbott Laboratories, Air Reduction, Union Carbide, Douglas Aircraft, and Jones & Laughlin.

At the low, DuPont showed a loss of more than 7 points, a drop which brought the industrial average down sharply.  
American Motors at its high registered its best price of the year. It declined later on profit taking. Ford lost more than 3 points and then met support. Chrysler at its low was down more than a point.

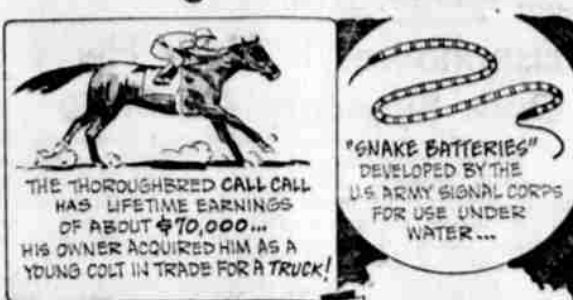
