

New Vet Law Affects WWI Servicemen

Veterans who were discharged as aliens during World War I may be entitled to pension or compensation as a result of a law signed by the President on July 28, the Veterans Administration informed The Observer today.

Prior to the new law, World War V veterans discharged as aliens were required to prove that they did not request their own discharge.

The new act, Public Law 86-113, presumes that these veterans did not request their own discharge unless the government establishes proof that they did.

Although the VA will review all such cases on file that can be identified where claims for pension or compensation have previously been denied, the VA suggests that all veterans who believe they may be eligible for benefits under this new law file claims at their earliest convenience.

In the case the new claims are approved, the VA explained, the benefit payments may begin as of the date the claim was filed under the new law.
