TELEVISION IN REVIEW:

'Jazz Singer' Too Burlesque Casting Jerry Lewis As Star

NEW YORK (UPI)—An attempt to recreate the classic story, "The Jazz Singer," on NBC-TV Tuesday night was so obviously sincere that it was a pity it was so cliché-ridden and often misguided.

The familiar story by Samson Raphaelson was adapted and modernized by Ernest Glucksmann and Ralph Nelson (producer and director, respectively, of Tuesday night's presentation, second in the new Star-Times series).

Jerry Lewis starred as Joey Robins, Cantor Rabinowitz's son, who broke his father's heart by breaking a family line of five generations of cantors to go into show business.

Because there was only an hour for the story, there was no time to explore the merits of the father-son conflict, or to present full portraits of each. Nor was there an attempt to resolve the question, although the play did make the point that children cannot roam too far from their heritage.

The conflict was set up in such lines as this, recited by the cantor, played by Eduard Franz: "If our young ones move away, who will be left to record the heart-breaks?"

Lewis said later on: "Without audience acceptance, I am nothing."

The telescoping caused many of the serious scenes to take on burlesque-style dimensions, for every line had to cover too much ground. It had to try to present symbolic values as well as down-to-earth ones, and when characters become open symbols, they make for troublesome dialogue.

By burlesque-style scenes, I mean such things as: Joey's arrival home during his father's birthday party, when his father slaps him for joking about ritual and says, "Better I should be

Emmy-Winning Writer Tosses In Sponge On Network War

HOLLYWOOD (UPI)—Rod Serling, Emmy-winning TV scripter, has thrown in the sponge in his lengthy war against networks and sponsors now that he's producing his own TV series.

"The sponsor is king in television," Serling said grudgingly. "And he always will be. It's a fact of life we must live with."

This total surrender just about eliminates the rebellious young men who once fought tooth and nail for uncensored scripts. Rod was one of the last of them.

Trouble With Sponsors
"I never got along with sponsors when I was a writer," he said. "That's why I'm producing my own show. There still are restrictions, but now I'm dealing directly with the sponsor and running into less trouble."

"The situation finally reached the heights of stupidity when normal words couldn't be mentioned because they also were the names of competing products. I had to take a line out of a script that read, 'have you got a match?'" The show was sponsored by a lighter company.

"Nobody can be 'lucky' on a program that is sponsored by a cigaret firm, and criminals can't go to the gas chamber if the guys picking up the check manufacture gas stoves."

Serling's new show, "The Twilight Zone," already has come a cropper with sponsors, but Rod doesn't fight them.

"I'm too busy trying to prove a pet theory of mine," he said.

Has Tremendous Scope
"I believe we can tell a story in the half-hour time restriction, and make it legitimate and interesting. This show is adult, meaningful, arresting drama which I hope will be both an artistic and commercial success."
