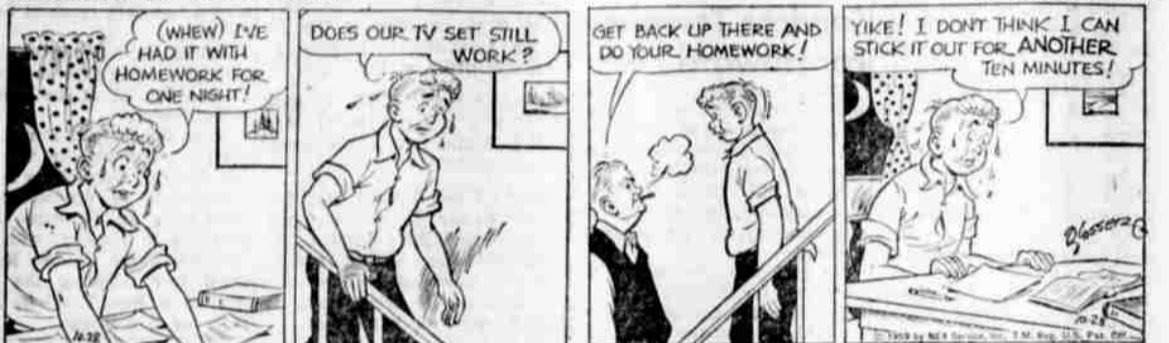

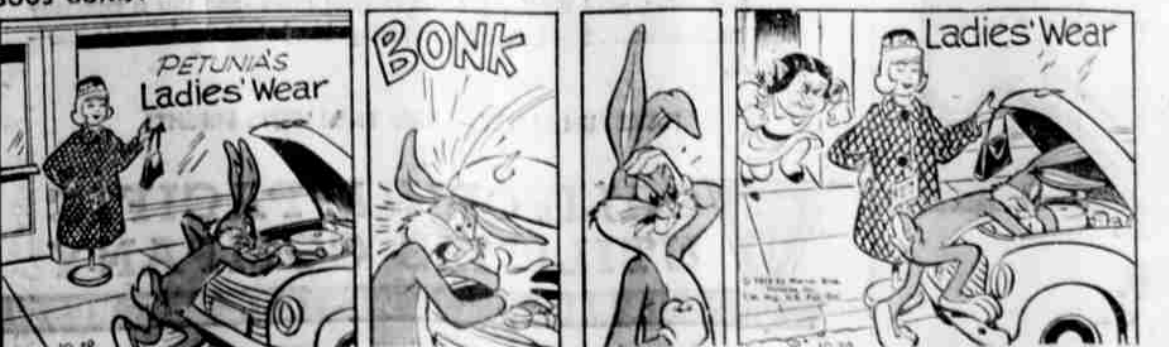

Hallmark Fame Opens Video With 'Winter' Showing

By FRED DANZIG UPI Staff Writer NEW YORK (UPI)—The poetic melodrama of Maxwell Anderson's "Winter" received a surprisingly faithful reading Monday night as the season premiere of NBC-TV's Hallmark Hall of Fame series.

To find the fire and blood of this 24-year-old drama bouncing along in a TV drama sponsored by greeting cards — where fluffier stories were presented in past seasons — was noteworthy in itself.

Anderson's allegorical "Winter," of course, is a showcase for the bitter dialogue and cynicism born of a spiritual and economic depression. But it ends in a triumphant bath of newly-discovered love.
