

Halloween Warning On Pranks

SALEM (UPI) — Naughty spirits who might have it in mind to soap a few windows this Halloween got a warning from Attorney General Robert Y. Thornton today.

While there is no specific state law against soaping windows, Thornton said that any bit of mischief that amounts to defacing property is severely frowned upon.

The attorney general gave his approval to such school or church sponsored activities as collecting funds for the United Nations annual appeal for aid to underprivileged children.

Laws Passed

He warned, however, that state law forbids anyone to falsely represent or pretend to be obtaining money for a charitable cause.

Oregon's lawmakers may have done their share of soaping pumpkins in their youth, and don't mean to be killjoys now, the attorney general allowed. But the fact remains, he said, that they've passed a list of laws that do mean to eliminate vandalism on All Hallow's eve — or any other time, for that matter.

Even the ghosts or witches who are traditionally supposed to frolic in graveyards at midnight had better be careful, because there are state laws against disturbing the dead, toppling gravestones, or otherwise being a nuisance in cemeteries.

Many Objects Protected

In ancient Anglo-Saxon times, cemeteries were called "God's Acre" and were held to be sacred, hence not a proper place for fun and games. Today, stiff punishment may await those who aren't duly respectful of contemporary morals regarding the deceased. Even more antique prohibitions against even mentioning the names of the departed, however, are no longer enforced.

Besides grave markers, there are a great many specific objects protected by state law from damage or defacing including: Buildings, crops, fences, gates, hedges, machinery, monuments, motor vehicles, shrubbery and signposts, Thornton said.

Russ Photograph Behind The Moon Great Feat

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Nobel Prize scientist Dr. Harold C. Urey says the Soviet photograph of the moon's far side is "an outstanding technical achievement" which should spur this country to greater efforts in space.

Urey agreed with other scientists here that the Russian photo was not detailed enough to warrant conclusions about the nature of the moon's other side.

But he said it was impossible to exaggerate the technical skill which enabled the Russians to get the picture at all.

"It is time," Urey said Tuesday "that we get up out of our chairs and begin to compete with them in space. It is not good for us to kid ourselves that we are up with them. We are not. I think it will be years before we are."

Some astronomers, who did not want to be quoted by name, also stressed what one called the "marvelous technical accomplishment" manifested by the photograph.

One scientist said the technique used by the Russians could have tremendous military significance.
