Steel Firms **Forgetting** Expansion

NEW YORK (UPI) staggering losses suffered most steel companies in the third quarter is forcing these firms to take a hard second look at their future expansion and modernization plans, Iron Age magazine said today.

Most companies will go ahead with announced programs, the metal-working weekly said, but some "will be hard-pressed nancially to follow through with immediate plans."

Nearly all, the magazine added, will be affected to the extent that future programs will be reappraised or delayed.

The publication pointed out that tooling orders from hard - hit steel users also have been deferred. While auto makers retooling programs, toolmakers say it is very difficult to "get decion programs that have

been long under study.
At the same time Iron Age said some shortages of consumer goods can be expected in the winter months. Autos in parti-cular will be in short supply with car output dropping to less than half of normal production for the period.
