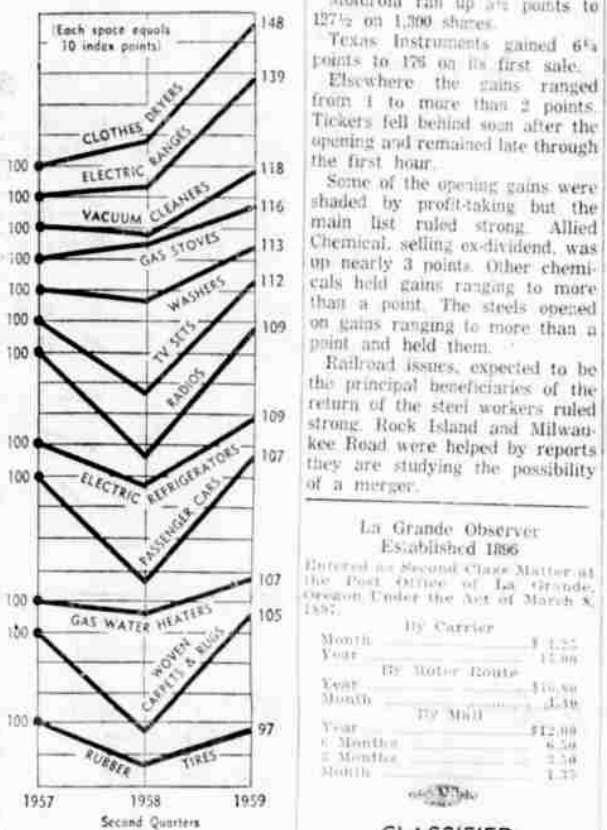

**NEW YORK STOCKS**  
 NEW YORK (UPI)—The stock market today responded with a vigorous rise to the indication which sent the steel workers back to their jobs on Saturday.  
 Shorts covered and new buying came into the list even though many in Wall Street believe the so-called 20-day cooling off period will produce less steel than consumers need and may be followed by another strike.  
 Shortly before 11 a.m. e.p. the Dow-Jones average and, initially, showed a rise of 5.21 points and rails were up 1.90 points.  
 Industrials have risen 7 1/2 of the past 11 sessions. For the rails today's gain was the second in nine sessions.  
 Advances in the market ranged to more than 3 points with the rails, steels, motors, metals, electronics, tires, aircrafts, and chemicals among the best gainers. Just about every group participated except the oils where small gains and losses balanced each other. Opening trades ranging to more than 10,000 shares helped swell trading volume which for the past two weeks has been averaging more than three million shares daily.  
 Zenith Radio ran into an accumulation of buy orders and its opening was delayed. The issue ran up 4 1/2 points to 115 1/2 on 7,000 shares.  
 Motorola ran up 5 1/2 points to 127 1/2 on 1,200 shares.  
 Texas Instruments gained 6 1/2 points to 176 on its first sale.  
 Elsewhere the gains ranged from 1 to more than 2 points. Tickers fell behind soon after the opening and remained late through the first hour.  
 Some of the opening gains were shaded by profit-taking but the main list ruled strong. Allied Chemical, selling ex-dividend, was up nearly 3 points. Other chemicals held gains ranging to more than a point. The steels opened on gains ranging to more than a point and held them.  
 Railroad issues, expected to be the principal beneficiaries of the return of the steel workers ruled strong. Rock Island and Milwaukee Road were helped by reports they are studying the possibility of a merger.
