TELEVISION IN REVIEW:

Alec Guinness Portrays His Ability In 'Startime' Play

NEW YORK (UPI) — A knight of the British Empire, Alec Guinness, dominated a night of American television Tuesday.

Guinness made his TV dramatic debut here in an hour play called, "The Wicked Scheme of Jehal Deeks," part of NBC-TV's Startime series.

Because the part was tailored for Guinness' uncanny ability to utilize a scheming, fox-grauba facial expression — including that superb wide smile that unfolds as he surveys the chaos he has created — the play wasn't much of a challenge for him. He's been unbeatable in this sort of movie, but it was still a great treat to have him do his stuff for mere TV viewers.

Jehal Deeks, for 27 years, worked in a bank and was conspicuously underpaid and unappreciated. He thirsts for revenge. He wants his revenge to be complete. And he wants to be around to savor it. That rules make good the loss. No, reasons Deeks, embarrassment "doesn't really humiliate them."

He then, upon a better idea. He begins putting his own money into the tellers' receipts. Chaos results. The bank's antisepic efficiency becomes infected with tension and near-panic.

Next, Deeks mixes up the paychecks. A bank guard gets \$375 and the bank vice president gets \$43.18. Chaos results. Deeks gets forward with some suggestions and eventually, an efficiency engineer — expertly satirized by William Redfield — comes along.

Deeks keeps his grandstanding going and locks the board chairman in the vault. There was this fine line from the pre-sterile banker in the vault. "I'm not counting my money. I'm reviewing my holdings." Dynamic from the banker and Deeks is on his way up, as the new director of procedures. He stops the Willie Sutton — in reverse activities — merely by doing nothing, and is about to become bank president when, yes, someone else begins adding money to the till.
