

Emotional Conflicts Faced By Child Actors In Movies

HOLLYWOOD (UPI)—The conflicts and small tragedies of child actors are clearly mirrored in Robert Blake who is undergoing psychotherapy to straighten out his tangled life.

Blake, who never attained stardom, was acting steadily at the age of 5. By the time he was 14 he had worked in hundreds of movies, including 35 co-starring roles as Little Beaver in the "Red Ryder" series and some 50 "Our Gang" comedies.

He's 26 now, back in the acting business, but admittedly in need of a skull mechanic.

"I was like most child performers," he said bitterly. "I acted only because I was told to, and you can hardly consider what I did acting."

Left Home At 14

"I didn't like it. It was no kind of a life. I had nothing going for me at school or at the studio or at home. So when I was 14 I packed up and left home."

From pampered child actor Bob drifted from job to job, mostly manual labor with construction outfits. At one point he hied off to New York to work as a box boy in a grocery store.

Then Bob put in a two-year hitch in the Army—in Alaska yet—where he switched from the infantry to special services.

After his stretch in the service, Bob discovered there was no money coming to him from his childhood earnings. It had all been spent.

Calls Law "Baloney"

"All that stuff about the so-called 'Jackie Coogan law' protecting earnings of kid stars is just baloney," he said. "My money— and there was plenty of it—just disappeared. It went to support the family."

"Someday I'll write a story about the Hollywood children—the Scotty Becketts, Alafia Switzers and Spanky McFarlands. Facing a kid to become a performer is one of the worst things that can happen to a child. It's turning them into adults while they're still youngsters."

"Even now when I see a kid working on a set it depresses me."

"I was never a child star," he concluded. "I was a child worker. And it's something I would never do to any children I may have."

Forest Service Examining Baker Area Mining Claims

The U. S. Forest Service is examining the national forests and will continue to cooperate with legitimate miners.

Formal public notice regarding the determination of surface rights on mining claims in the Eagle, Baker "C" and Twin areas will appear in local newspapers for nine consecutive weeks. In addition, a copy of such notices will be delivered to persons whose names and addresses are determined as provided in the new law. The owner of a mining claim located prior to July 23, 1955, will have 150 days after the first publication to assert surface rights if he chooses to do so.

A claimant may ignore the notices, thereby waiving rights to the surface until the claim goes to patent, yet maintaining his original mining rights. The claimant may file a verified statement asserting his rights to the surface. In that case his claim will be examined by mineral examiners.

If his rights are considered valid, the Forest Service will probably recognize such rights and not attempt to establish the public's rights to control the surface resources under the new law. Claims of questionable validity will be considered before a hearing officer of the Bureau of Land Management, Department of the Interior, which will make the final decision. Both the claimant and the Forest Service will present their testimony at the hearing. Whatever the decision the claimant will retain his mineral rights. If the decision is in the claimant's favor, he also retains all surface rights.

Maps of the Eagle, Baker "C" and Twin areas now being examined and copies of the Multiple-Use Mining Law of July 23, 1955, and of the procedure for the determination of surface rights set up by law are available for inspection at the Forest Supervisor's office, Baker.
