39-Week Diet Trims 144 Pounds From Woman

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (UPI) — A Memphis woman lost 144 pounds during a strict 39-week diet of three light liquids and a baby-like formula. The woman was one of three "seriously overweight" volunteers taking part in a study of obesity by the University of Tennessee division of medicine, it was revealed Friday. The woman trimmed down from 473 to 329 pounds on the program. Besides tea, water and black coffee in prescribed amounts, she was fed a "milk shake" formula four times daily. The formula was based on dried milk and had adequate protein, fat, carbohydrate, vitamin and mineral content.

Marlon Brando 'Qualified' To Discuss Merits Of Myths

HOLLYWOOD (UPI) — Marlon Brando knows about myths. He film, continues to refuse to discuss personal matters. He'd rather let friends and enemies believe what they want. "The public is predisposed to believe things about me before they meet me," he went on. "What they read is generated by newsmen I've refused to see because I don't wish them to write about my personal life. "I cannot understand why anyone wants to know the small personal matters of my life. If it were interesting that would be one thing, but it is just curiosity. Exchanging Views "On the other hand, with people I like I am more than willing to discuss any personal issues— providing the person is genuinely interested in exchanging views and feelings. "But when the interest is superficial they are just titillating themselves, and I cannot be a part of that. Brando has little sympathy for fellow actors who bare their private lives. "It's an incredible psychic phenomenon," he observed. "Imagine, some of them even have photographers taking pictures of the births of their children. Unbelievable! "I'm not discussing my private life now, nor will I do so in the future. Let the myth grow or die of its own accord."
