U.S. 'Horn Of Plenty' Running Out For European, Asian Allies

The United States has told its European and Asian allies that the horn of plenty is running low.

Not low enough as yet to be a danger to the American economy, but enough to bring about a serious reappraisal of U. S. military and foreign aid expenditures and for the United States to tell its allies that they now must help to shoulder some of the burdens formerly borne by the United States almost alone.

In their extreme, these steps could mean a return to high U. S. tariffs and the development of a kind of economic isolationism.

The warning was aimed at those nations who have received unstintingly of U. S. aid, while at the same time erecting barriers against U. S. goods to protect their own recovering economies.

And it pointed up the inequality of a situation in which the United States in 1959 alone, suffered a four billion dollar trade deficit while others prospered.

These nations were quick to take the hint.

In rapid-fire order Japan, Britain and France announced moves to lift restrictions against the "made in U. S. A." label.

Sweden noted that five times this year, she has reduced restrictions against U. S. goods, the result has been that in world capitals from Tokyo to London, other governments also have faced up to a reappraisal and with surprising unanimity have decided that the United States has carried the burden long enough. They will help.

Since 1949, with the exception of one year, the United States has had a trade deficit with other nations which by the middle of this year had reached a staggering total of nearly 15 billion dollars.

Accompanying the deficit has been a flow of gold away from the United States totalling nearly five billion dollars.

It has been a cause for growing concern for the reasons that no nation can exist forever on a deficit and that an unbroken outflow of gold eventually must be reflected in reduced faith in the U. S. dollar.

So it was for these reasons that U. S. Under Secretary of State Douglas Dillon warned in a speech last October that either other nations must put their financial shoulders to the wheel or face the possibility the United States would take steps to protect itself.

Oregon Cranberry Crop Said Safe
