**No Evidence Of Philippine Charge**  
WASHINGTON (UPI)—The Defense Department says it has no evidence to back up a congressman's charges that the Philippines government is harassing U.S. troops and winking at large-scale looting of American property.  
But the department said it would be glad to investigate any specific allegations by Rep. Phil Weaver (R-Neb.), a member of the House defense appropriations subcommittee who returned recently from the Philippines.  
Chairman George Mahon (D-Tex.) announced, meantime, that the subcommittee would investigate Weaver's charges. He said U.S. Pacific field commanders would be summoned to Washington to testify, as Weaver demanded.

**New Outboard Motor Weighs Mere 34 Lbs.**  
The smallest outboard motor in or near its power class is the new 7.5-horsepower Scott engine made by the Marine Products Division of McCulloch Corp. It is only 39 inches high and weighs just 34 pounds, is 27 pounds lighter than previous motors of this size.  
Other features of this motor that will appeal to fishermen are a lower powerhead to keep it out of the way of fishing lines, and a new and different lower unit and propeller that enable it to push through grassy obstacles without becoming snarled.  
This new motor was designed from scratch to specifications set up by a survey of 2,000 of the nation's top outdoor and angling experts.

**Candy Barr Sheds Mate, Reweds; Faces Vegas Rap**  
LAS VEGAS, Nev. (UPI)—Stripper Candy Barr was divorced Wednesday, married Wednesday night and today faced a 15-year Texas prison sentence.  
The shapely exotic dancer said she was "in a fog" about what to do over her troubles.  
She learned only Wednesday that the U.S. Supreme Court had turned down her latest appeal, leaving her with little chance other than to journey back to Dallas to begin serving the sentence meted out in 1957.  
Miss Barr, free on \$5,000 bond, wed Jack Sahakian, 38, a Beverly Hills, Calif., beauty shop operator, less than 12 hours after her first husband divorced her in Dallas.  
Troy B. Phillips divorced Miss Barr in Dallas on grounds of cruelty and desertion. She shot him in the stomach in January, 1956, but he did not press charges, according to police.
