**WASHINGTON (UPI)**—The current Census Bureau count of the nation's farms may become an important factor in farm belt politics next year.

**WASHINGTON (UPI)**—The Agriculture Department estimates that there are about 4,700,000 farms in the country. Some congressional farm experts believe that the new census will show no more than 4,100,000 farms and perhaps as few as 3,700,000.

**WASHINGTON (UPI)**—The Agriculture Department reported today that farm wives have been taking outside jobs at a faster rate than non-farm women.

The report covered the 1950-1958 period during which farm incomes fell and farm families turned increasingly to non-farm jobs.

The department said the percentage of farm wives holding outside jobs increased by one-third, from 17 per cent to 24 per cent.

The percentage of city wives holding jobs outside the home rose by about one fourth, from 26 per cent in 1950 to 32 per cent in 1958.

**WASHINGTON (UPI)**—Agriculture Department economists said today the nation's farmers would have to pay a bigger wage bill for hired help in 1960.

The economists said farm labor outlays this year would total \$2,600,000,000 in wages and nearly \$500,000,000 in board, housing and other benefits.

They predicted that farm wage rates, which rose six per cent this year, would rise again in 1960. Farmers were expected to replace some of their employees with machines next year. But the increase in wage rates was expected to more than offset the reduction in numbers of workers.
