

# Benson Claims His Interest Strictly For The Farmers

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Agriculture Secretary Ezra T. Benson admits that his critics have succeeded "to some extent" in picturing him as a man without sympathy for farmers.

But actually, Benson said, his "whole interest" is the welfare of farmers and all Americans. He again indicated that he would not resign because some farm belt Republicans consider him a political liability in farm areas.

"Some of our opponents have made a desperate effort to make it appear the Secretary of Agriculture is not sympathetic to farmers," Benson said in a radio interview Thursday.

"To some extent those efforts have been successful."

Asked if he would resign next year if it appeared he was damaging his party's prospects, Benson said:

"I'm not one that runs away
