

# Problems Of Tight Money Solved By Small Businesses

NEW YORK (UPI) — Small business is solving problems of tight money through long-term leasing of production equipment.

And equipment leasing in turn has become big business for several firms which are able to raise sums of money more readily than the little business man.

Robert Sheridan, president of Nationwide Leasing Co., third largest unit in its field, told United Press International that leasing is going to become an integral part of corporate finance for large and small business.

He explained that the little

business man faces difficulty raising capital and without leasing would have to rely on outdated, inefficient equipment.

**Big Firms Lease Too**

Big firms find leasing advantageous too. Sheridan cited a billion-dollar oil company with annual credit and working capital which leased a big analog computer because it could treat it as an expense rather than capitalize it and depreciate it year by year over its life.

A big mid-west supermarket leased \$75,000 of equipment from Nationwide, including nearly 100 items ranging from a \$17 chess cabinet to \$7,000 of cash registers.

A chicken processing company in Arkansas leased \$80,000 in special processing equipment. A Florida drive-in leased its kitchen and drive-in equipment. A hospital leased all its equipment. A state bank in Illinois leased calculating equipment.
