Plight Of Farmer More Of Political Issue Than Ever

WASHINGTON (UPI) - The plight of the farmer became a hotter political issue today following a report by the Agriculture Department that its parity index skidded in November to a new 19-year low.

The department's parity formula in its monthly report stood at 77 per cent, compared with 79 per cent in mid-October and 84 per cent in November. It meant the farmer was being squeezed between a smaller income and rising living costs.

It also meant the farmer was down to his lowest level in 19 years in terms of what his dollar would buy. And farm prices tumbled to the lowest level in more than 2 1/2 years in straight dollar-and-cents terms.

The report showed that prices received by farmers for crops and livestock fell 2 per cent in the month ended Nov. 15. Hog prices were at the lowest Nov. 15 point since 1955; cotton prices were the lowest for the month in a decade.

Prices paid by farmers for goods stood at a new high of 297 per cent of the base period, compared with 296 in mid-October and 294 in mid-November, 1958.

The troubles down on the farm merely added grist for the politicians' mills. The report was interpreted as a new blow to Republican hopes in the Farm Belt, where Democrats have made sharp political gains in recent years.

WASHINGTON (UPI) - The National Agricultural Advisory Commission is expected to repeat its endorsement of the Administration's farm policy for next year when it ends its two-day closed meeting here today.

The commission, which meets four times each year, usually has shaped its advice on key issues to coincide with administration policy.

Agriculture Secretary Ezra T. Benson has shown the group his 1960 five-point program, which includes new wheat legislation and expansion of the conservation reserve program.

WASHINGTON (UPI) - A marketing research team says that installation of water-sprinklers in trucks can save farmers some money on the cost of marketing hogs in hot weather.

The Agriculture Department said Monday that it keeps hogs cool, reduces weight shrinkage and deaths on the way to market on long and medium-long hauls. It can save about \$72 a truckload on hauls of 27 hours, but little or no savings on short hauls of less than five hours.
