## Greek Orthodox Priest Now President Of Tiny Country

A black-bearded priest of the Greek Orthodox Church becomes the newly-elected president of a newly-born state on Sunday (Dec. 13).

He is Archbishop Makarios II. The new state is Cyprus, an island about the size of New Jersey containing approximately a half million people of whom four-fifths are of Greek origin.

The new vice president will be Fazil Katchuk, a man of Turkish origin.

The constitution of the new republic provides that the president be Greek, the vice president

Turkish. Both Makarios and Katchuk are assured of election.

The elections Sunday are a prelude to the actual date when Cyprus is supposed to take over its own destiny, which is Feb. 19.

**Has Uncertain Future**

It will be a state with a bloody past and an uncertain future.

Cyprus' strategic location, 40 miles off Turkey in the eastern Mediterranean, has made it a favorite target of conquerors for more than 2,000 years, beginning with Alexander the Great.

Its most recent history of violence began with demands of the Greek majority for "enosis" (union) with Greece, a proposal violently opposed by the Turkish minority, as well as by Turkey.

In the resulting dispute, involving Britain, Greece and Turkey in addition to Cyprus itself, Makarios became the political firebrand and a man named Col. George Grivas, the leader of the fighting underground.

**Underground Declares War**

In 1955, the underground declared war on the British and the shooting began.

Hundreds were killed and thousands wounded in the fighting which raged with no holds barred for the next four years, and the scars still run deep.

Greece and Turkey, allies in NATO, came to the verge of war. Greek and Turkish Cypriot battled each other and outrages against each still burn in memory.

Early this year, Britain, Turkey and Greece, with Makarios sitting in for the Cypriots, agreed that Cyprus should become an independent state.

It was an agreement satisfactory to no one.

## It's Costing Much More For Education

United Press International

Fees at many of the nation's colleges and universities are on the rise, following the pattern of increased enrollments during the past few years.

It's going to cost more to get a college education, a United Press International survey disclosed.

Rising costs, including higher faculty salaries were given as the main reasons for the increase in fees and tuition.

Stanford University, privately endowed, reported a tuition increase from \$750 to \$1,005 per school year during the current semester.

California Institute of Technology, Pasadena, a private school, said tuitions were raised from \$900 to \$1,275 in September and the teaching staff was granted a general pay boost during the year.

The University of California, with nine campuses throughout the state, reported a \$50 raise in tuition for out of state students. The university was not planning to increase salaries.

Tuition at the University of Oregon, Eugene, and Oregon State College, Corvallis, was raised \$33 a year for residents and \$66 a year for students from out of the state during this school year.
