Don Guyer, Tom Bessonne, Baker, and Herb Carroll, were club guests for the day. Al Kaiser was program chairman.

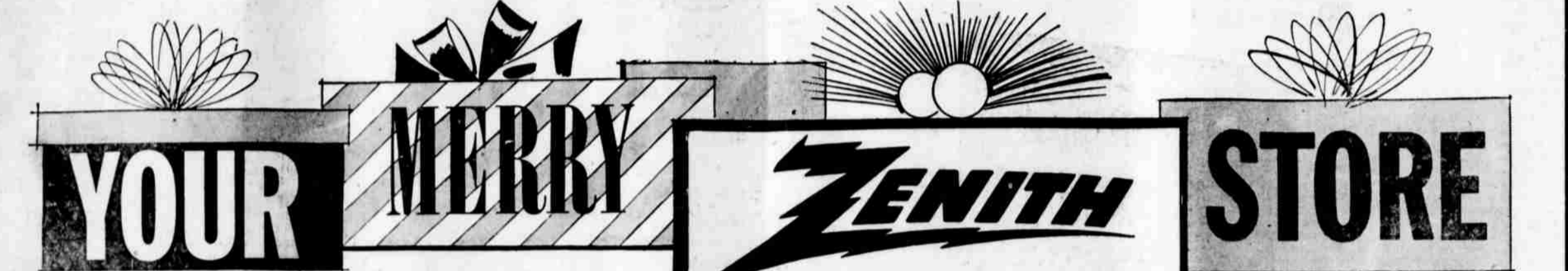

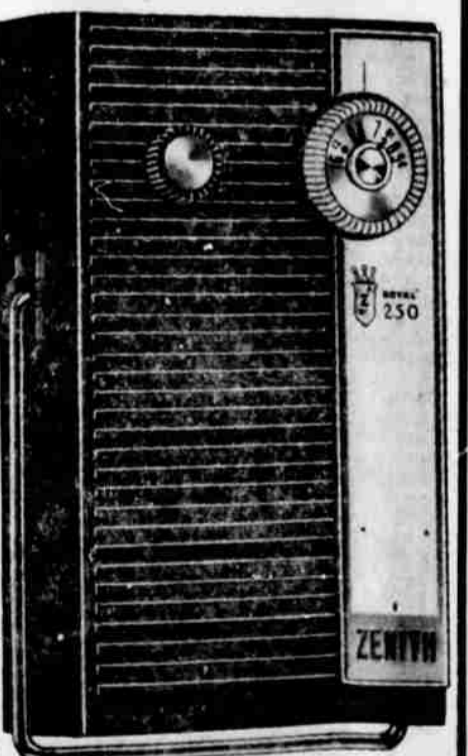
