Georgia Tech Figures To Be Tough In Bowl

This sort of play was typical of Georgia Tech all season—win or lose! Only in a 16-6 victory over Bluebonnet Bowl-bound, Atlantic Coast Conference champ Clemson was a final result assured before the final gun.

This was a Tech team that was hampered throughout the season by injuries. At one point, four of the top five halfbacks were on the bench. And, in the losses to Alabama and Georgia in the last two games of the season, the Yellow Jackets had offensive quarterback Fred Braselton shelved with a shoulder injury.

Has Versatile Attack
At full strength, Georgia Tech has a versatile attack. The Jackets are especially dangerous outside with their speed. With Braselton available to keep the Arkansas defense honest, Tech's running game will be hard to stop. Billy Williamson, Floyd Faucette, Chick Granning and Frank Nix head up what is probably the deepest halfback corps in the South.

The Georgia Tech defense, sparked by All-America center Maxie Baughan, is big and rugged.

Tech Coach Bobby Dodd is known for his ability to prepare his team for big games. This is his ninth Tech team to be invited to a post-season bowl — and he hasn't lost one yet.

The Ducks controlled both backboards and picked off 49 rebounds to San Jose's 30. Glenn Moore had 14 rebounds for the Ducks but was held to only four points by Dennis Marc. Moore had gone into the game with a 22 plus average.

Charlie Warren and Dennis Strickland took up the scoring slack hitting 12 and 11 points respectively.

Vir Barnes topped the visitors with 19 points. Marc followed him with nine points.

The win was Oregon's fifth against a single loss. San Jose State stands 2-4 on the season.
