compensation law.

Employers pay payroll taxes now on the first \$3,690 cf employe

now on the first \$3,600 cf employe income but after Jan. 1 the first \$3,800 of income will apply.

The unemployment trust fund is expected to be increased by about one million dollars per year by the change. Also, 10,000 employers will come under the unemployment pay system with the advent of the one-employe statute.
