The ballot title meets the require-ments of the Oregon Constitution. The certified ballot title is as fol-Caption: Prohibiting Cer-

tain Marijuana Registrants and/or Licensees in Unity, Oregon

Question: Shall Unity prohibit medical mariiuana processors. medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers. processors, wholesalers, and retailers within City Limits?

Summary: State law al-

lows operation of registered medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries and licensed recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers. State law provides that a city council may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters to prohibit the establishment of any of those registered or li-

censed activities.

Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment and operation of medical marijuana processors, medical marijuana dispensaries, recreational marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers within the area subject to the jurisdiction of the City, provided that state law allows for continued operating of medical marijuana processor and medical marijuana dispensaries already registered, or in some cases, that have applied to be registered, and that have successfully completed a local land use application process.

f this measure is approved, the city will be ineligible to receive distributions of State marijuana tax revenues and will be unable to impose a local tax or fee on the production, processing or sale of marijuana or any product into which marijuana has been incorporated.

Pursuant to ORS 250.275, any elector dissatisfied with this ballot title may petition for review of the ballot title. The petition must be filed no later than the seventh business day after the title was filed (September 17, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.). The appeal procedures are outlined in ORS
