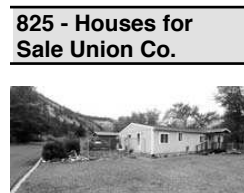

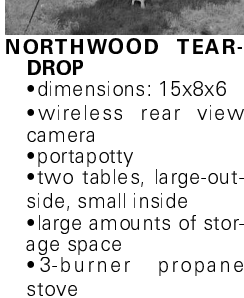

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, the Union County Planning Commission, meeting in regular session, Monday, October 22, 7:00 p.m., in the Daniel Chaplin Building Conference Room, 1001 Fourth Street, La Grande, will consider an application submitted by the City of La Grande, Michael Boquist-agent, for Union County to co-adopt the City of La Grande Land Development Code Ordinance 3242, Series 2018, affecting all properties within the City of La Grande City Limits and Urban Growth Boundary. The amendments include housekeeping changes throughout the entire land use code; establishing a medical services zone for the Grande Ronde Hospital campus; and adopting rules for marijuana facilities, livestock, accessory dwelling units, and cottage (tiny) homes.

The applicable Land Use Regulations are found in Section 23.05 of the Union County Zoning, Partition and Subdivision Ordinance. Failure to raise a specific issue with sufficient specificity at the local level precludes appeal to LUBA based on that issue. 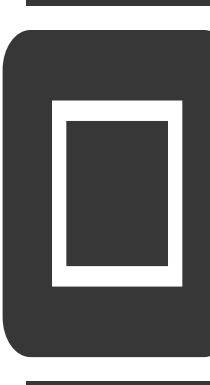

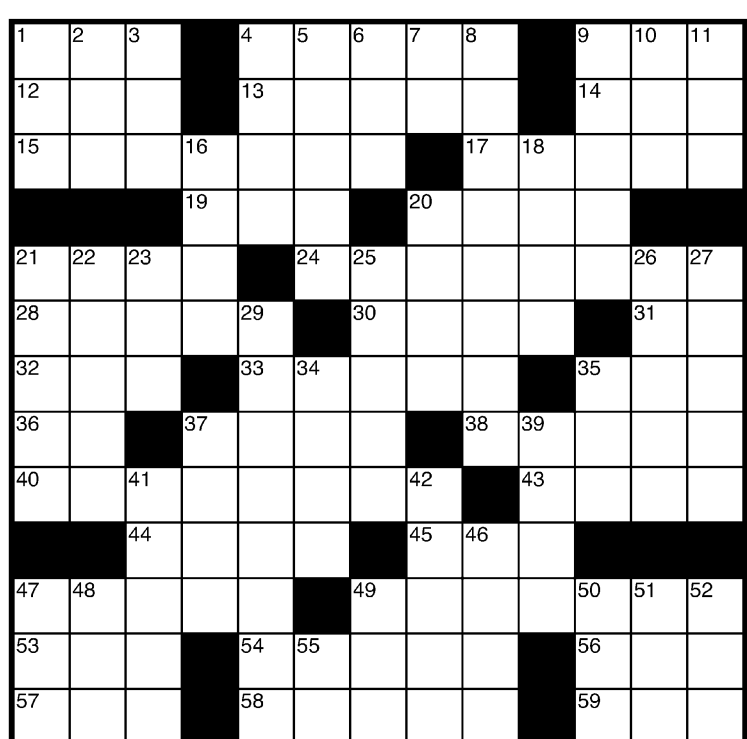
