### **SUBMIT AN EVENT**

- 2. Enter the details of the event to check whether someone else has already input details for your event.
- 3. If not, fill out the form as directed. You can add multiple dates for ongoing or recurring events.
- 4. You will have a chance to review your details then submit and finish or submit and close.
- 5. There are options to pay for higher play on the calendar, but it is not necessary. You can submit events for free.
