

Tigers take second at home

Most of the players at the La Grande Invitational Tuesday felt they could have done better, whether it was due to the course at La Grande Country Club still being wet from the rain that delayed the tournament a week or just an off day.

"It was a bit of a rough day," La Grande girls Head Coach Cally Goss said after her Tigers took second overall with a score of 433. "They've had better

rounds.... But that's golf."

Morgan Tussey shot a team-best 98 and was third overall to lead the Tigers.

She agreed with her coach in calling the day a challenge, but also said her play could have been improved.

"The course was pretty wet still, (but) I could have done a lot better," she said.

Tussey said her putting was what kept her score down. That included draining a 15-footer on

her final hole that had her leaping for joy as it guaranteed she'd stay in double digits.

"I knew I was right on the edge of 100," she said of her reaction to draining the putt. "Putting was good today. I really saved a lot of strokes."

Tussey edged teammate Katie Williams for top team honors, as Williams finished with a score of 104. Baylee McNeil added a score of 115, and Tori Bowen had a 116.

LHS struggles with Bulldogs

The La Grande Tigers tennis team had a tough afternoon in its home match against rival the Baker Bulldogs Monday, winning just five of the 18 contests at La Grande High School.

The boys team went 3-6 on the day, with the wins coming in No. 4 singles where Ashton Morwood edged James Hayes, 8-7 (7-3), and in No. 4 and No. 5 doubles. There, Colm Cahill and Adam Remily earned an 8-3 victory, and

Cayson Forsberg and Mason Mellinger picked up an 8-2 win.

The top three in both singles and doubles, though, all lost in straight sets. Forsberg dropped a 6-4, 6-3 match to Zach Schwin, Cahill lost to Shane Cunningham, 6-1, 6-0, and Remily dropped a 6-1, 6-1 match to Alex Davila.

In doubles, James Thurman and Scott Remily lost to Luke Barnes and Issac Nemeec, 6-1, 6-2, Mellinger and Gabe Blackman dropped a 6-4, 6-1 match to Eli Lien and

Anthony Cowan, and Devin Ingram and Caden Johnson fell, 6-3, 6-3.

The LHS girls finished 2-7, with Katelin Banes earning a 6-0 win over Corrina Stadler in No. 5 singles and Maylen Tommy and Brenna Bushman posting a 6-5 victory in No. 4 doubles.

But the Tigers won just one game in the other four singles matches. Tommy fell to Hannah Johnson, 6-0, 6-0; Rebecca Conklin dropped her match to Gabbie Trebilcock, 6-0, 6-0;
