New art shows open Friday

A new month means new art shows in Baker City. Galleries throughout town will stay open late to welcome visitors on the first Friday of the month, Sept. 6.

CROSSROADS 2020 AUBURN AVE.

Crossroads Carnegie Art Center unveils the 21st annual open regional show "Art at the Crossroads" beginning at 5:30 p.m. Friday.

"We're expecting a wide range of interesting and new work from local and regional artists that patrons are sure to appreciate," said Crystal Rainwater, community art director.

The community is also invited to a discussion and critique with this year's judge, Kirsten Furlong, at 10 a.m. Saturday.

PETERSON'S GALLERY 1920 MAIN ST.

Baker County artist Andrew Gettle will present his show of dynamic 3-D pieces titled "Introduction to Perspective."

The show is described as "demonstrating the act of looking at situations with a 360-degree perspective."

Churchill School's Hall Pass Gallery will feature the work of Carol Connett. First Friday will also feature open studios of Jennifer Godwin, Amy VanGaasbeck and Brian Vegter.

"I enjoy creating possible realities, morphing species and the rules of nature," Connett said. "While viewing these pieces, keep in mind there is no 'right answer' — your interpretation is just as valid as mine."

"Sometimes it takes months before I fully understand my own

paintings. Sometimes I never do..."

Connett said she's begun to incorporate textiles and quilting into her paintings.

"The possibilities of this combination feel endless," she said. "It offers me another dimension to tell my stories. This is a direction I intend to explore more in the future."
